As an Agent in the Traffic Bureau, I was responsible for approving traffic collision reports. To approve these reports, it required comprehensive knowledge and expertise in the S.W.I.T.R.S. manual. S.W.I.T.R.S. stands for Statewide Integrated Traffic Records System. It is a statewide repository of collision data for all allied law enforcement agencies and it is maintained by the California Highway Patrol. In essence, this is the traffic collision bible.

I feel I can assist City Council and Traffic Engineering in making Chula Vista a safe place for the community by providing my knowledge, training, experience.
