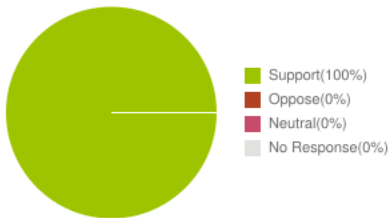

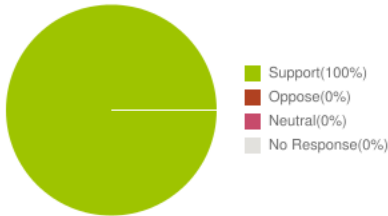

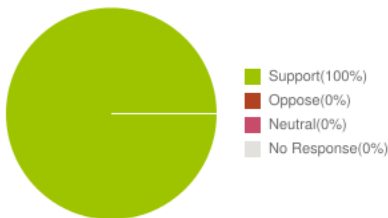

Green Fee Structure Chula Vista Municipal Golf Course

People who live in this CITY, pay taxes to this City, vote in this CITY and mostly shop in this CITY are

RESIDENTS.

Currently, a NON RESIDENT can and does pay a ONE TIME fee of \$25 to purchase a card that allows that NON RESIDENT to pay the same green fee as a RESIDENT. A NON RESIDENT senior does not have to pay the one time fee of \$25, but pay the same rate as a RESIDENT senior.

I urge Council to consider this issue in any proposed green fee increase.
