RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA APPROVING THE REVISED FISCAL YEAR 2017/2018 COMPENSATION SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 5, 2018, AS REQUIRED BY CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 2, SECTION 570.5 TO REFLECT SALARY INCREASES FOR THE FA DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND FA DIRECTOR OF THE SAN DIEGO LAW ENFORCEMENT COORDINATION CENTER

WHEREAS, California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Section 570.5 requires that, for purposes of determining a retiring employee's pension allowance, the pay rate be limited to the amount listed on a pay schedule that meets certain requirements and be approved by the governing body in accordance with the requirements of the applicable public meeting laws; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Compensation Schedule ("Compensation Schedule") was last amended by City Council at their meeting on December 12, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the salaries for the FA Deputy Executive Director and FA Director of the San Diego Law Enforcement Coordination Center (SD LECC) are tied to federal salaries schedules, which have increased; and

WHEREAS, the Compensation Schedule will be revised to reflect the salary adjustment for the FA Deputy Executive Director and FA Director of the SD LECC, retroactive to January 5, 2018, due to changes in attendant federal salary schedules.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it approves the revised Fiscal Year 2017/2018 Compensation Schedule effective January 5, 2018, as required by California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Section 570.5, to reflect salary increases for the FA Deputy Executive Director and FA Director of the San Diego Law Enforcement Coordination Center.
