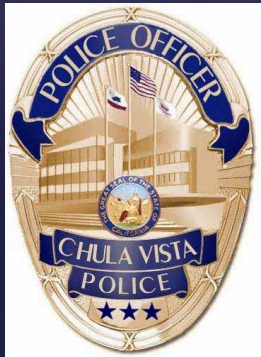


Ordinance Requiring Responsible Alcohol Beverage Service (RBS) Training for On-sale Licensees

Addressing Alcohol Issues

- **Community concerns** of drunken behavior at or near bars
 - 12 community workshops organized by PD from September 2009 to January 2014 with neighbors and stakeholders in attendance
- **CVPD Efforts**
 - Undercover operations
 - Increased Extra Patrol by officers
 - Street Team Officers assigned to problem solve
 - Worked with Engineering on parking and lighting issues

RBS Ordinance Highlights

- **On-sale only** – licensees, managers, employees at Chula Vista's ~**165** restaurants, bars
- **LEAD** (Licensee Education on Alcohol & Drugs) or **RBS** training **within 6 months** of ordinance, start of business or start of job
- **Training** – preventing over-service to adults, service to minors
- Training certificate valid for **4 years**

RBS Ordinance Highlights, cont'd

- ABC provides **LEAD** training at no cost in South Bay
 - Several trainings hosted by CVPD, NCPD, IB Sheriff
 - Countywide survey of participants: 99% recommend training
- **RBS** training by private providers is low-cost, available in several formats
- **No City fees** or reimbursement
- **No opposition** to date
 - 2 letters sent—2/24/14 and 4/10/14
- **9** other cities in the county require RBS training:
 - Imperial Beach, National City, El Cajon, Carlsbad, Solana Beach, Encinitas, Vista, San Marcos, Poway

RBS Ordinance - Compliance

- **Show proof** of training to SIU upon request
 - Compliance Form available on CVPD website
 - Employee and business information, date of training, training location and provider, certificate or proof of completion
- **Violations** are infractions subject to CVMC 1.41:
 - \$100, \$200, and \$500 fines for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd violation in one year
