RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING \$275,076 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, AUTHORIZING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE RADIO DISPATCH CONSOLE EQUIPMENT FROM MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC. BASED ON THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO'S CONTRACT NUMBER 553982 PRICING AND TERMS AND APPROPRIATING SAID FUNDS TO THE FEDERAL GRANTS FUND FOR THE URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, the San Diego Office of Homeland Security, who administers the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI), has notified the City of Chula Vista of fiscal year 2015 UASI additional funding; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Area Security Initiative addresses the unique planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs of high-threat, high-density urban areas; and

WHEREAS, grant funds from the Urban Area Security Initiative are restricted as to how the funding can be spent and cannot supplant normal budgetary items for the City; and

WHEREAS, the fiscal year 2015 UASI additional funding will purchase equipment and installation services, the equipment will be located and used at City of San Diego Fire Dispatch to dispatch City of Chula Vista Fire Department first responders; and

WHEREAS, the equipment funding includes four P25 compatible radio dispatch consoles to upgrade the current dispatch consoles; and

WHEREAS, The County of San Diego conducted a competitive procurement for a new regional communications system and established contract number 553982 with Motorola Solutions, Inc. as a result of the competitive procurement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Chula Vista accepts \$275,076 from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, authorizes the Fire Department to purchase radio dispatch console equipment from Motorola Solutions, Inc. based on the County of San Diego's contract number 553982 pricing and terms and appropriates said funds to the capital category of the federal grants fund for the Urban Area Security Initiative.
