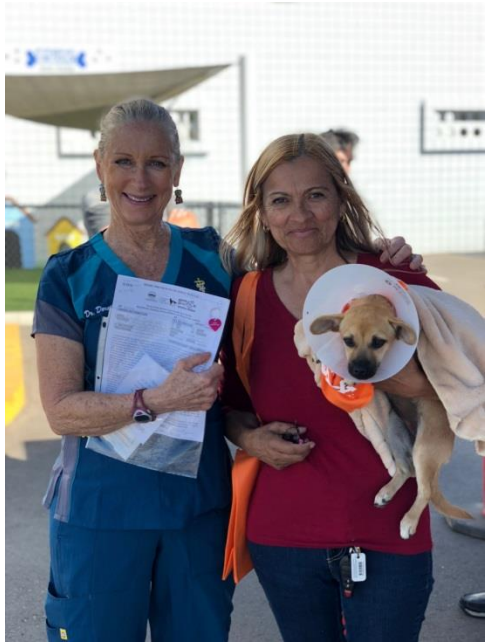

How it works: 1. Come in or visit www.cvacf.org and complete the Spay/Neuter Interest Form by February 19 to be entered into our lottery. We will contact you if selected.

2. Animals must be two months or older and be in good health. NOTE: You will need to provide proof of residency (utility bill, rental agreement, etc.)

3. Drop off your dog at 8 a.m. to the CVACF (130 Beyer Way) on surgery day. Pick up is between 2 - 3:30 p.m.

After 3:30 p.m., boarding charges will apply.

Low Cost Spay or Neuter options for your Dog or Cat

The Chula Vista Animal Care Facility (CVACF) encourages owners to spay and neuter their pets. There is a serious pet overpopulation problem in San Diego County. You can be part of the solution. Animals must be two months or older and be in good health.

We offer limited appointments for low cost public spay/neuter surgery (\$75) for residents from any zip code. Income qualifying residents from Chula Vista, Lemon Grove, and National City may qualify for free.*



- 1 Come in to sign up!
- 2 Drop off your dog or cat to the CVACF (130 Beyer Way) at 8 a.m. on your pet's scheduled date.
- 3 Pick up is usually between 2 – 3:30 p.m.
After 3:30 p.m., boarding charges will apply.

*To qualify for the free Spay/Neuter program you will need to provide proof of residency (utility bill, rental agreement, mortgage statement, etc.) and income verification (SSI, AFDC, WIC, EBT, Medicaid, etc.). A \$10 deposit is required.
