RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CHULA VISTA WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE FORMAL BID  
PROCEDURE AND APPROVING AN AGREEMENT (“TASER  
QUOTATION”) BETWEEN THE CITY AND TASER  
INTERNATIONAL FOR THE PURCHASE OF BODY WORN  
CAMERAS, EVIDENCE STORAGE, AND RELATED  
PRODUCT-SUPPORT SERVICES

WHEREAS, since 2010 the Chula Vista Police Department has extensively researched and tested body worn cameras; and

WHEREAS, Taser International is an industry leader in manufacturing and supporting ruggedized body worn cameras that are specifically designed for police use; and

WHEREAS, Taser International was the first company to recognize cloud storage as the most secure and economical method for storing digital evidence and developed Evidence.com; and

WHEREAS, no other manufacturer offers a combination of high quality equipment paired with an evidence storage solution on par with Evidence.com; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department recommends contracting with Taser International to provide body worn cameras, cloud-based storage of digital video evidence, and support services to assist with implementation, training and data management; and

WHEREAS, the total cost over a five-year contract for 114 body worn cameras, docking stations, data storage and related product-support services is \$501,294; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is requesting that the City Council waive the formal competitive bid procedure in Chula Vista Municipal Code Section 2.56.070 because Taser International’s unique commodities, services and performance capabilities make them a Sole Source provider pursuant to Section 2.56.070.B.4.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it waives the competitive bid procedure in Chula Vista Municipal Code Section 2.56.070 because Taser International is a Sole Source provider of unique commodities, services and performance capabilities pursuant to Section 2.56.070B.4; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it approves the Agreement (“Taser Quotation”) between the City and Taser International for the purchase of body worn cameras, evidence storage and related product-support services in the form presented, with such minor modifications as may be required or approved by the City

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Attorney, a copy of which shall be kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk, and authorizes and directs the Mayor to execute same.
