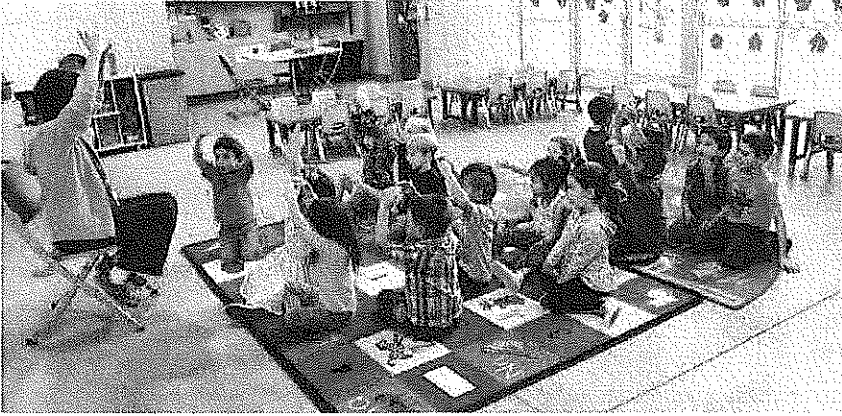

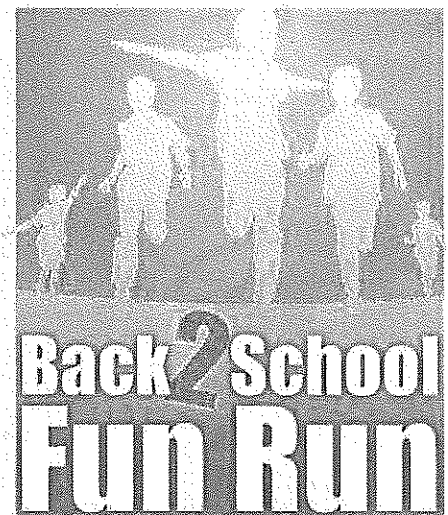
## BACK2SCHOOL 1 MILE FUN RUN

**Fees: \$10 Res. / \$12 Non (Register in advance)**

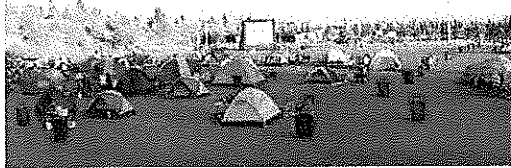
**\$15 Res. / \$18 Non (Day of the event)**

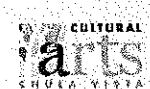

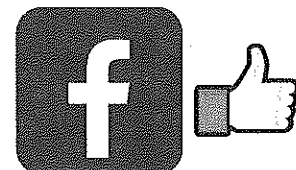
