RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM CALRECYCLE'S LOCAL GOVERNMENT HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DISCRETIONARY **GRANT** PROGRAM. **APPROPRIATING** \$90,000 TO THE **WASTE** MANAGEMENT AND RECYCLING FUND, AND AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL GRANT DOCUMENTS AND IMPLEMENT PROJECTS FUNDED BY THE GRANT

WHEREAS, California Public Resources Code sections 40000 *et seq.* authorize the Department of Resources and Recovery (CalRecyle) to administer various grant programs in furtherance of the State of California's efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the State thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, the City received a grant award from CalRecycle of \$90,000 for the household hazardous waste discretionary grant program for Grant Cycle 2015-16; and

WHEREAS, these funds are provided to collect and properly dispose of household batteries and single-use gas cylinders via collection receptacles at retail sites and other convenient locations throughout the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista that it accepts the grant award in the amount of \$90,000 from CalRecycle and appropriates \$90,000 to the Supplies and Services (\$70,725) and Other Expenses (\$19,275) categories of the Waste Management and Recycling Fund.

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it authorizes the Public Works Director or Designee to execute all grant documents and implement projects funded by the grant.
