RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA APPROVING THE NAME "GREG COX PARK" FOR THE 3.2-ACRE BIKE SKILLS PARK FACILITY LOCATED IN THE OTAY VALLEY REGIONAL PARK, RECREATION AREA 6 AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING STAFF TO UNDERTAKE ADDITIONAL ACTIONS AND SEEK ADDITIONAL APPROVALS AS MAY BE NECESSARY FOR SUCH NAMING

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2020, the City Council approved Resolution 2020-095 approving a new 3.2-acre bike skills park facility in the Otay Valley Regional Park (OVRP), Recreation Area 6 (the "Park Facility"); and

WHEREAS, Greg Cox served as a Chula Vista City Councilmember from 1976 to 1981; and

WHEREAS, Greg Cox served as Mayor of Chula Vista from 1981 to 1990; and

WHEREAS, Greg Cox has represented the City of Chula Vista and the rest of the First District on the San Diego Board of Supervisors for the last twenty-five years; and

WHEREAS, Greg Cox has championed outdoor activities and facilities for the South Bay and has been a driving force behind the Bayshore Bikeway; and

WHEREAS, Greg Cox has been a strong advocate for the Chula Vista Bayfront Redevelopment, the establishment of the Olympic Training Center (now Chula Vista Elite Athlete Training Center), and the continued operation of the Living Coast Discovery Center; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to recognize the lifetime contributions of Greg Cox to the City of Chula Vista by naming the Park Facility "Greg Cox Park."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it hereby approves the park name "Greg Cox Park" for the 3.2-acre bike skills park facility located in Otay Valley Regional Park, Recreation Area 6.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it authorizes and directs staff to undertake additional actions and seek additional approvals as may be necessary for such naming.
