SAFETY PROTOCOLS

- Face masks are required to enter any City facility.
- Temperature checks will be required upon entry to Community Centers and Libraries.
- 6-ft distancing must be maintained between members of different households.
- Sanitize all areas and equipment as needed.
- Community Centers capacity limited to no more than 50 people per facility.
- PPE (hand sanitizer, masks, etc.) will be available.
- Facilities will be disinfected at beginning and end of each day.
- Signage stating protocols and directional signage will be clearly posted throughout the facilities.
- No concessions.

CIVIC CENTER LIBRARY



- 7 day/week operations
 - Monday-Thursday (10am-8pm)
 - Friday & Saturday (10am-5pm)
 - Sunday (1-5pm)
- Limited Occupancy: 25% capacity (roughly 80 people)
- Browsing will be available.
- First Come, First Served Computer Use will be limited to one hour.
- Passport Services will continue.
- Curbside Services will continue.
- Limited Programming will be available.
- The ability to sit and study will only be available on the library deck.

- South Branch will remain closed.
- Otay Ranch Branch will remain closed to the public and continue to provide Passport Services and Curbside Services.
- The Library's highest priority is to continue to work towards opening all branches at full service.
