RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AMENDING RESOLUTION 2016-005 TO REMOVE THE ELECTION OF MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL, DISTRICT 3, FROM THE JUNE 7, 2016 GENERAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2016, in accordance with the provisions of the Chula Vista Charter and State law, the City Council, through Resolution No. 2016-005, called a General Municipal Election to be held on June 7, 2016 for the purpose of electing two Members of the City Council, representing Districts 3 and 4, for the full term of four years, commencing in December 2016; and

WHEREAS, only two candidates submitted sufficient nomination papers and qualified for placement on the ballot for the General Municipal Election for the position of Member of the City Council, District 3; and

WHEREAS, Chula Vista Charter Section 300.A.3 provides that in this situation no General Municipal Election shall be held for the position and, instead, the qualified candidates should be considered for election to the position of Member of the City Council, District 3 at the November runoff election; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Chula Vista Charter and State law, the two qualified candidates for the position of Member of the City Council, District 3 shall therefore be placed on the ballot for the November runoff election; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista as follows:

SECTION 1. All of the foregoing recitals are true and correct.

SECTION 2. This resolution amends City Council Resolution No. 2016-005 to remove the Member of the City Council, District 3 from the ballot for the Tuesday, June 7, 2016 General Municipal Election because only two candidates submitted sufficient nomination papers and qualified for placement on the ballot for that position. In accordance with the Chula Vista Charter and State law, the General Municipal Election for the Member of the City Council, District 3 called for in Resolution No. 2016-005 will not be held and the two qualified candidates for the position shall be placed on the ballot for the November runoff election.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to provide a copy of this resolution to the Registrar of Voters.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and file it with the City's original resolutions.
