




California is Not on Track to Meet SB 375 GHG Targets






Travel Time from Chula Vista Northwest Employment Center












Where Workers Live South County Employment Centers

Employees place of residence






Where People Work South County Residents












Concentration of Employees Sorrento Valley

Dark Purple – Half Dark and Light Purple – Two-thirds




