RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING \$16,000 FROM THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO AND \$173,188 FROM THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND APPROPRIATING \$69,188 TO THE POLICE GRANT FUND FOR THE PUBLIC SAFETY REALIGNMENT

WHEREAS, in 2011, Governor Edmund G. Brown Jr. signed Assembly Bill (AB) 109 and AB 117 legislation, which enable California to close the revolving door of low-level inmates cycling in and out of state prisons; and

WHEREAS, this legislation implemented the 2011 Public Safety Realignment, which provides funding to counties to develop and implement evidence-based practices and alternatives to incarceration to limit future crimes and reduce victimization; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Sheriff's Department has been designated as the fiscal agent of the Regional Realignment Response (R3) funds and has allocated an additional \$16,000 to the City of Chula Vista for overtime operations to conduct regional compliance checks on probationers within the county; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has been designated as the fiscal agent of AB 109 Public Safety Realignment funds and has allocated \$173,188 to the City of Chula Vista; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department will spend \$53,188 in the current fiscal year for the Domestic Violence Response Team, equipment for task force vehicles and computers, as well as \$120,000 next fiscal year for the Juvenile Diversion Program and vehicles for the Investigations division.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Chula Vista does hereby accept \$16,000 from the County of San Diego and \$173,188 from the City of San Diego and appropriate \$16,000 to personnel services and \$53,188 to the supplies and services category of the Police Grant Fund for the Public Safety Realignment.
