

FOURTH AMENDMENT

**FOURTH AMENDMENT**

This FOURTH AMENDMENT ("Amendment") is entered into effective as of **August 1, 2016** ("Effective Date") by and between the City of Chula Vista ("City") and Advantage Sentry and Protection, Inc., also known as ASAP ("Consultant") with reference to the following facts:

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, City and Consultant previously entered into an Agreement to Provide Transportation Services for Prisoners ("Original Agreement") in August 2012 following City Council approval in Resolution 2012-153; and

WHEREAS, the Original Agreement was for a one-year term, August 1, 2012 to July 31, 2013, and allowed for five (5) additional one-year extensions by mutual agreement of the parties; and

WHEREAS, in subsequent years City and Consultant have administratively executed three (3) of five (5) one-year extensions of the Original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant now desire to extend the Original Agreement for a fourth one-year extension, as more specifically set forth in Exhibit A; and


WHEREAS, because of an increase in compensation to Consultant, City is submitting this Amendment to the City Council for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above recitals and the mutual obligations of the parties set forth herein, City and Consultant agree as follows:

1. Exhibit A, entitled Amended Compensation and Term, is hereby attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
2. Except as expressly provided herein, all other terms and conditions of the Original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
3. Each party represents that it has full right, power and authority to execute this Fourth Amendment and to perform its obligations hereunder, without the need for any further action under its governing instruments, and the parties executing this Amendment on the behalf of such party are duly authorized agents with authority to do so.
