RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING \$475,376 FROM THE  
CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY AND  
APPROPRIATING \$358,581 TO THE POLICE GRANT FUND  
FOR THE SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Police Department has been awarded \$475,376 grant funding from the California Office of Traffic Safety for the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program is to reduce the number of persons killed and injured in crashes involving alcohol and other primary collision factors; and

WHEREAS, throughout the one-year grant period of October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2015, DUI/driver license checkpoints, DUI saturation patrols, warrant service operations, distracted driving operations and other traffic enforcement operations will be conducted on an overtime basis; and

WHEREAS, funds provided by this grant will also be utilized for training and the purchases of a portable light tower and checkpoint supplies used during the traffic operations; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds provided by the California Office of Traffic Safety will completely offset the total costs of this program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City Council of the City of Chula Vista does hereby accept \$475,376 from the California Office of Traffic Safety, appropriates \$345,884 to the personnel services category and \$12,697 to the supplies and services category of the Police Grant Fund to be offset by grant revenue for the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program.
