RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING A HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE GRANT FROM CALRECYCLE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorize the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs in furtherance of the state of California's efforts to reduce, reuse, and recycle solid waste generated in the State, thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of its grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants; and

WHEREAS, the City received a grant award from CalRecycle in the amount of \$50,000 from the Household Hazardous Waste Grant Program for fiscal year 2019–20; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to use these funds to implement a new Household Hazardous Waste Reuse Program and onsite "Reuse Store" at the City's Household Hazardous Waste Facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it accepts the grant award in the amount of \$50,000 from CalRecycle and appropriates that amount to the Personnel, Advertising, Contracted Services, and Program Supplies budget of the Waste Management Fund.
