RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING \$70,000 FROM THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO AND APPROPRIATING SAID FUNDS TO THE POLICE GRANT FUND FOR REGIONAL REALIGNMENT RESPONSE EFFORTS

WHEREAS, in 2011, Governor Edmund G. Brown Jr. signed Assembly Bill (AB) 109 and AB 117 legislation, which enables California to close the revolving door of low-level inmates cycling in and out of state prisons; and

WHEREAS, this legislation implemented the 2011 Public Safety Realignment, which provides funding to counties to develop and implement evidence-based practices and alternatives to incarceration to limit future crimes and reduce victimization; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Sheriff's Department has been designated as the fiscal agent of the Regional Realignment Response (R3) funds; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department, in Amendment No. 3 to the funding allocation agreement with participating agencies, has allocated an additional \$70,000 to the City of Chula Vista for overtime operations to conduct regional compliance checks on probationers within the county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Chula Vista does hereby accept \$70,000 from the County of San Diego and appropriate \$70,000 to the personnel services category of the Police Grant Fund for Regional Realignment Response efforts.
