RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ADDING ONE GIS SPECIALIST TO THE AUTHORIZED STAFFING LEVEL OF THE FEDERAL GRANTS FUND

WHEREAS, the San Diego Office of Homeland Security, who administers the Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI), has notified the City of additional \$90,000 Fiscal Year 2014 UASI grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Areas Security Initiative addresses the unique planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs of high-threat, high-density urban areas; and

WHEREAS, UASI planning funds have been allocated to develop and enhance hazard plans used during emergency incidents around the region; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department is proposing to add one GIS Specialist to the authorized staffing level of the Federal Grant Fund to create and update All-Hazard Preplans for the San Diego region to new San Diego Public Safety Database standard; and

WHEREAS, the addition of this position will result in having two full-time GIS Specialists, a part-time GIS Specialist and an intern working on the regional UASI preplan project; and

WHEREAS, the GIS Specialist is fully funded by UASI grant funds and may be eliminated if grant funds end.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED with the above findings incorporated herein, the City Council of the City of Chula Vista does hereby approve the addition of one GIS Specialist to the authorized staffing level of the Federal Grants Fund for the Urban Areas Security Initiative.
