RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CHULA VISTA APPROVING MULTIPLE PROPOSAL
SUBMITTALS TO THE SAN DIEGO FOUNDATION AND
THE SAN DIEGO REGIONAL CLIMATE
COLLABORATIVE'S BUILDING REGIONAL RESILIENCE
GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, climate change poses a serious challenge and the City of Chula Vista was the first jurisdiction in southern California to develop comprehensive strategies to reduce the future risk and associated costs from local climate change impacts,

WHEREAS, expected local impacts include escalating temperatures and heat waves, changing precipitation patterns, rising sea levels, and increasing extreme natural events,

WHEREAS, the San Diego Foundation and the San Diego Regional Climate Collaborative released a request for proposals for a new Building Regional Resilience grant program to help local governments and public agencies implement plans and projects that address local climate change impacts, and

WHEREAS, City staff has worked with partner agencies and non-profit organizations to develop three grant proposals for submission, which align with the City of Chula Vista's current climate action strategies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it approves submittal of multiple proposals to the San Diego Foundation and the San Diego Regional Climate Collaborative's Building Regional Resilience grant program.
