RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CHULA VISTA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN
APPLICATION FOR THE STATEWIDE PARK PROGRAM
GRANT FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT
OF PARKS AND RECREATION OFFICE OF GRANTS AND
LOCAL SERVICES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PATTY
DAVIS PARK

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility by the Legislature of the State of California for the administration of the Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Grant Program, setting up necessary procedures governing the application; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the Applicant to certify by resolution the approval of the application before submission of said application to the State; and

WHEREAS, successful Applicants will enter into a contract with the State of California to complete the Grant Scope project; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to submit an application for the Statewide Park Program for the construction of a new park to be known as "Patty Davis Park."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Chula Vista hereby:

1. Approves the filing of an application to the Statewide Park Program for the construction of Patty Davis Park; and
2. Certifies that the City has, or will have available, prior to commencement of any work on the project included in this application, the sufficient funds to complete the project; and
3. Certifies that if the project is awarded, the City has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project, and
4. Certifies that the City has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the contract shown in the Grant Administration Guide; and
5. Delegates the authority to the City Manager or her designee(s) to conduct all negotiations, sign and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the Grant Scope; and
6. Agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and guidelines; and
7. Agrees to consider promoting inclusion per Public Resources Code §80001(b)(8 A-G).
