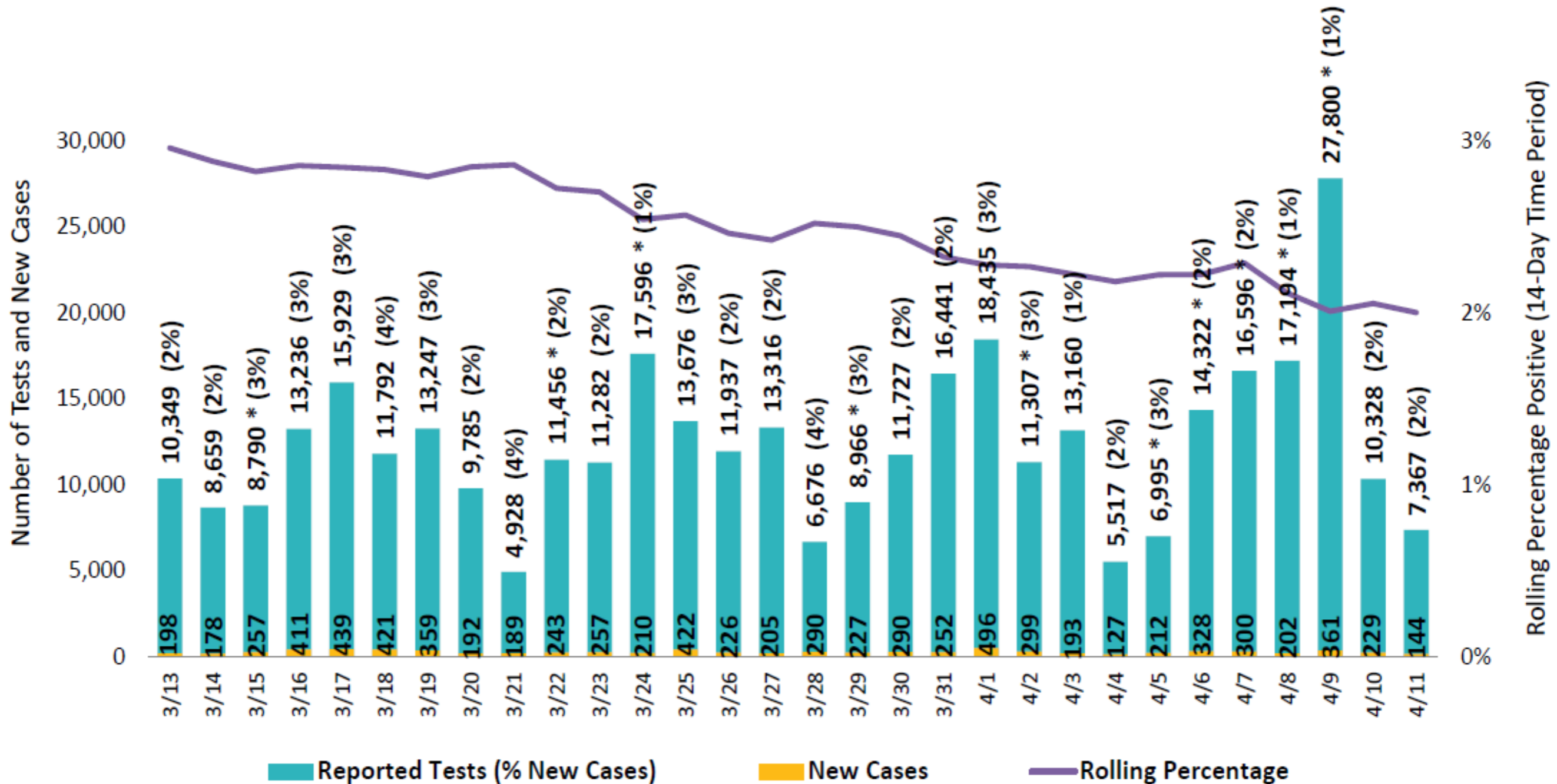

Total Number of Cases = 273,430

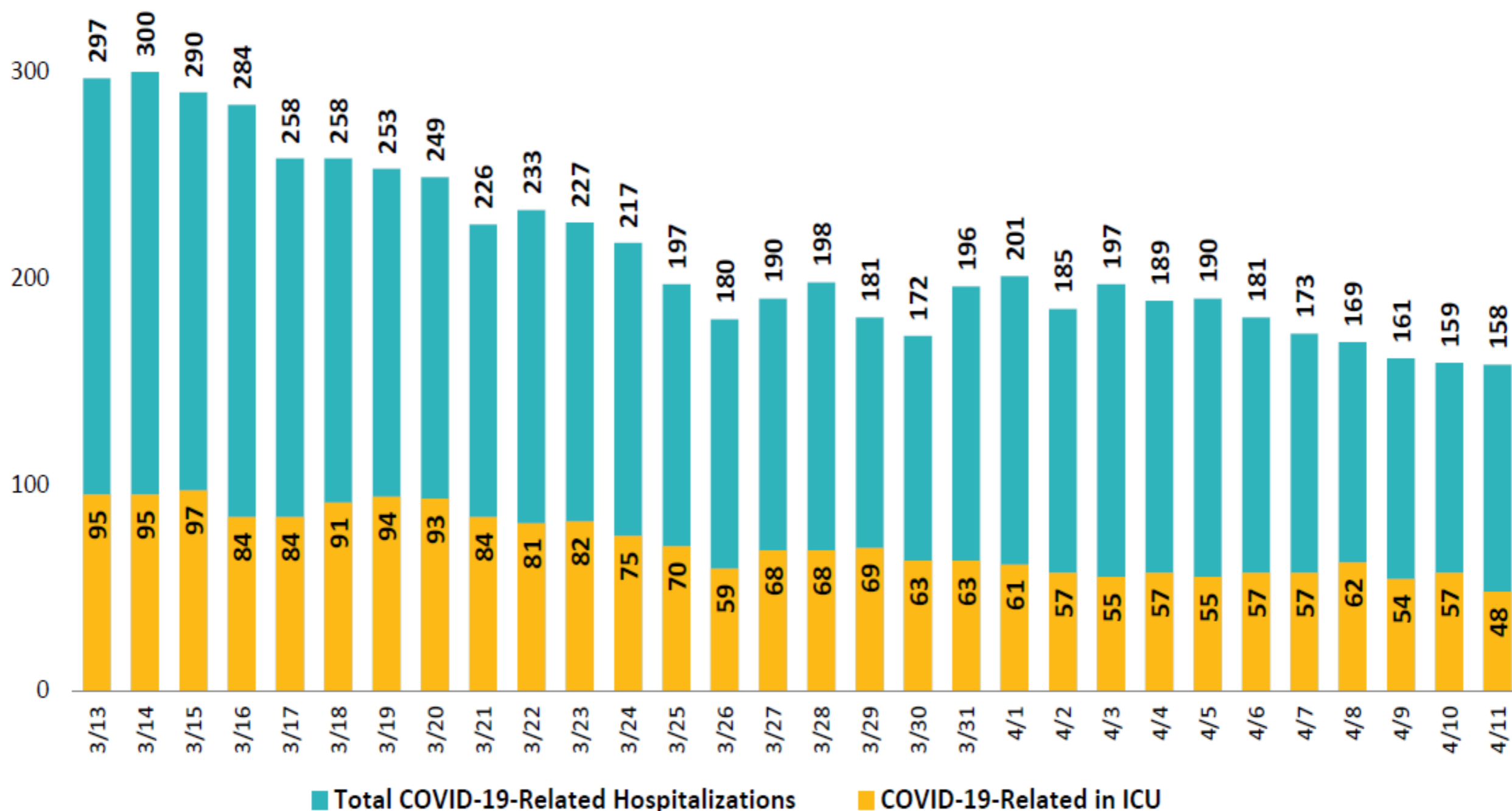

COVID-19 Hospital Daily Census in San Diego County Includes Cases and Suspect COVID-19 Patients

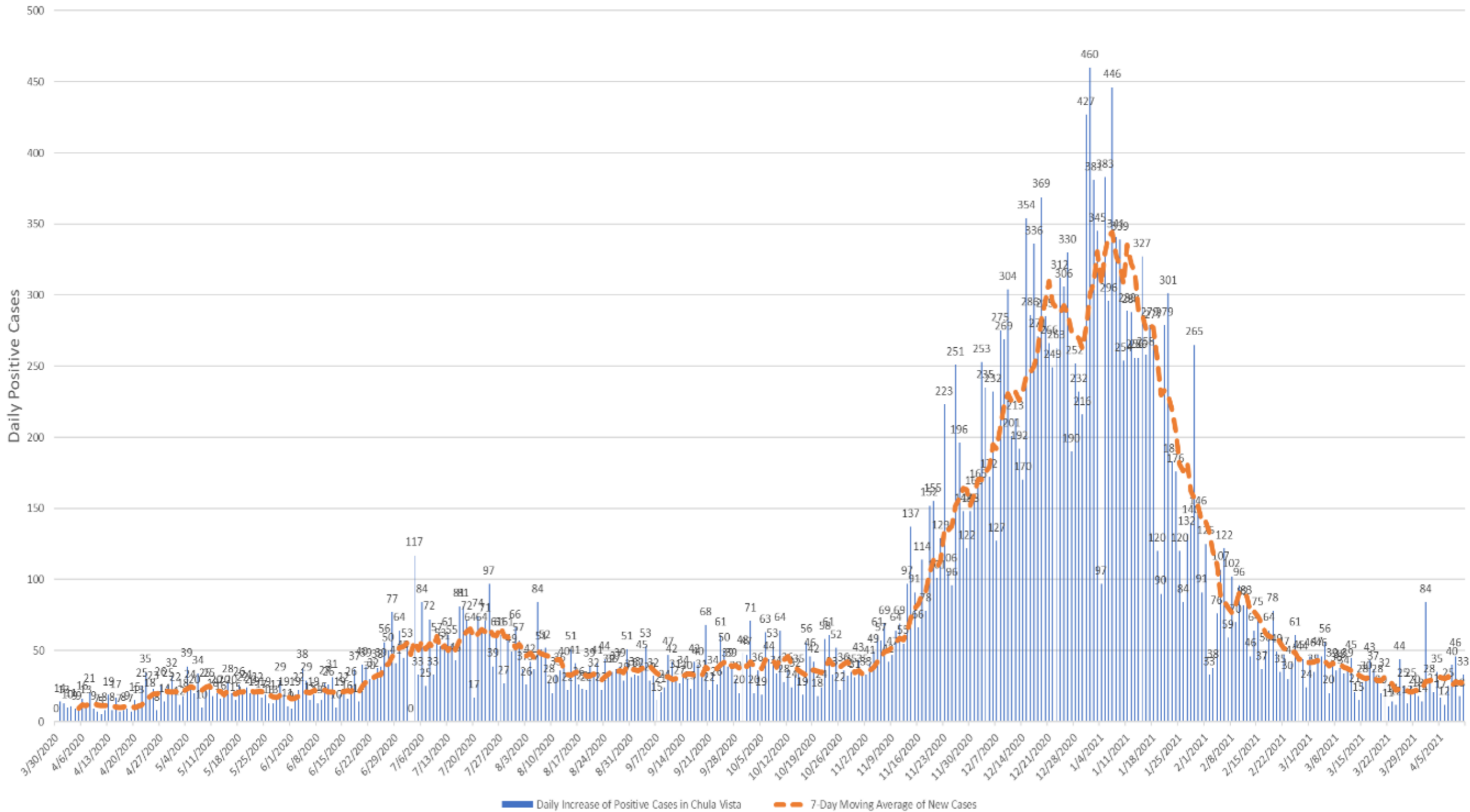

■ Daily Increase of Positive Cases in Chula Vista - - - 7-Day Moving Average of New Cases

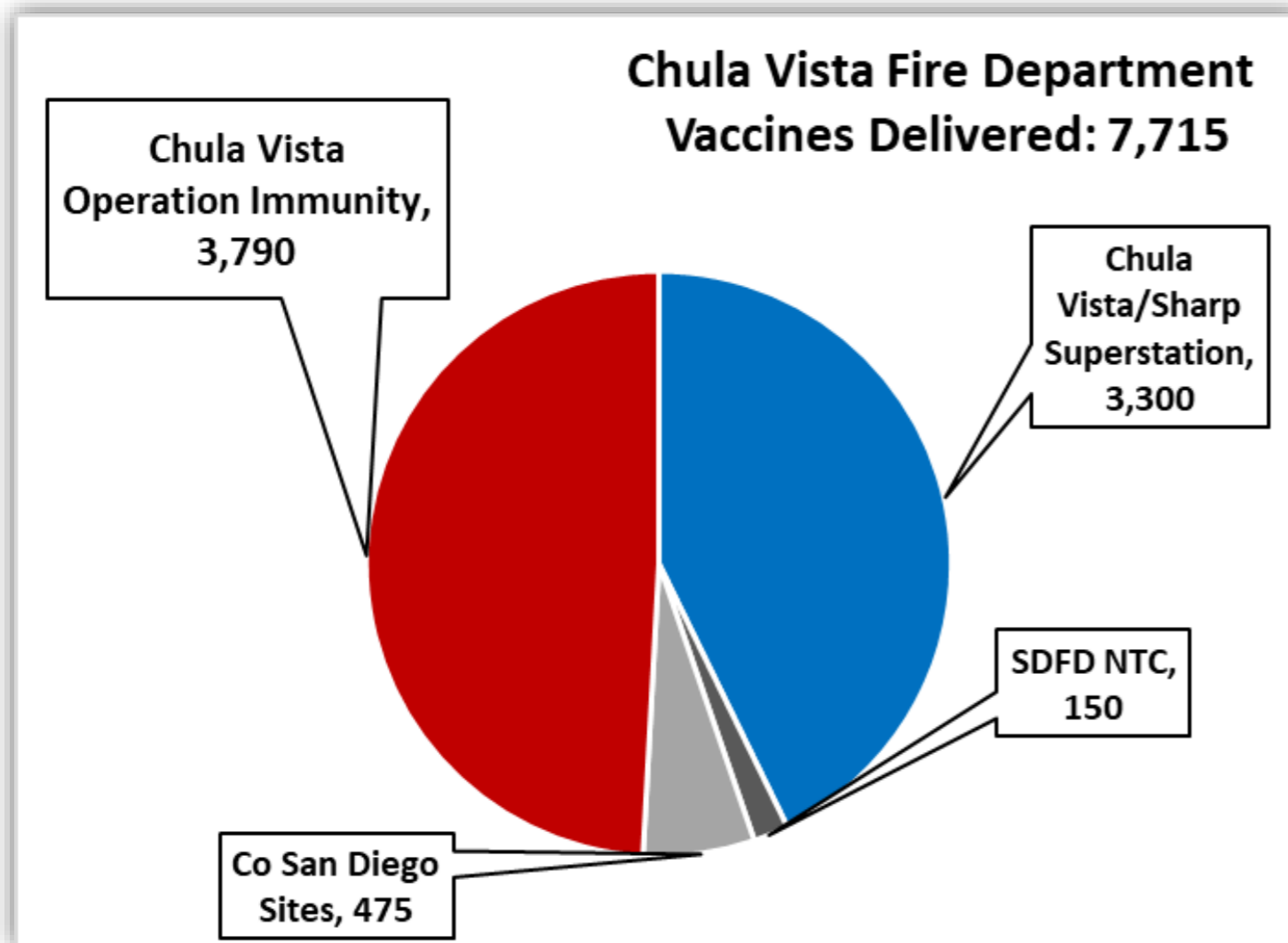

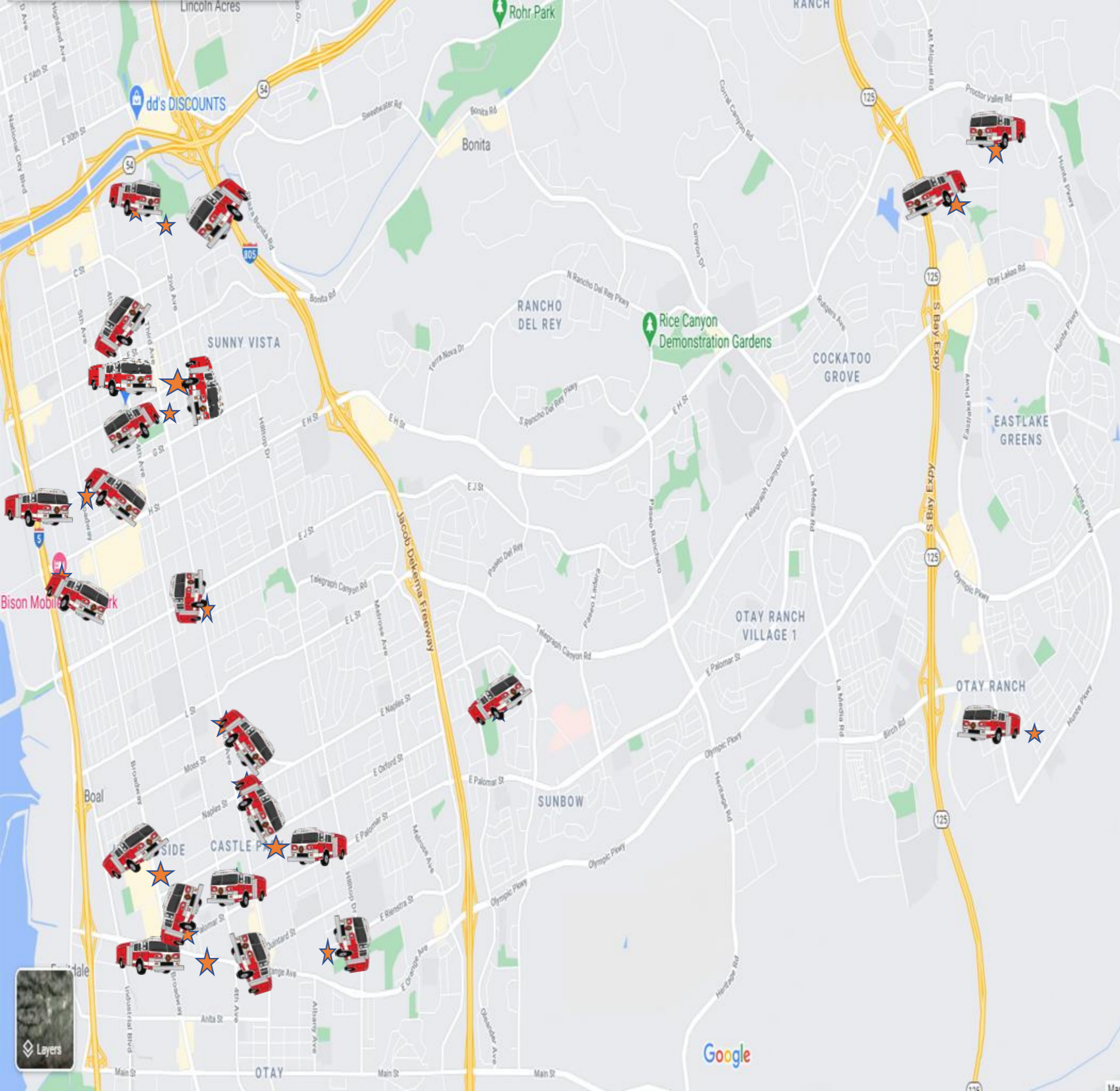

ORANGE TIER (CURRENT RULES)

 Retail & shopping centers (malls, destination centers, swap meets)	No capacity limits.
 Restaurants	Indoors can open at 50% capacity or up to 200 people, whichever is fewer. They are no longer required to close at 10 p.m.
 Gyms & fitness centers	Indoors can open at 25% capacity. Indoor pools can open.
 Wineries, breweries distilleries	Indoors can open at 25% capacity or to 100 people, whichever is fewer.
 Bars that do not serve meals	Can open outdoors.
 Family entertainment centers	Indoors 25%, includes bowling alleys
 Movie theaters, museums, zoos & aquariums	Indoors can open at 50% capacity. Movie theaters: Indoors can open at 50% capacity or up to 200 people, whichever is fewer.
 Offices	Indoors with modifications. Telework encouraged.
 Places of worship	Indoors can open at 50% capacity.
