NOTICE OF REVIEW AND PENDING APPROVAL OF FINAL MAPS

In accordance with California Government Code Section 66458(d), notice is hereby given that the City Engineer has reviewed and, immediately following this City Council meeting of December 13, 2016, will approve the following final maps:

Chula Vista Tract No. 13-01, 386 Date Street, for the property located at 386 Date Street.

Chula Vista Tract No. 12-05, Otay Ranch Village 2 South Neighborhood R-20, 68 single family units located on 12.690 acres South of Santa Victoria Road, east of Heritage Road and west of La Media Road Road.

Chula Vista Tract No. 12-05, Otay Ranch Village 2 South Neighborhood R-19B, 26 single family units located on 3.622 acres South of Santa Victoria Road, east of Heritage Road and west of La Media Road Road.

Chula Vista Tract No. 12-05, Otay Ranch Village 2 South Neighborhood R-23, 93 single family units located on 15.651 acres South of Santa Victoria Road, east of Heritage Road and west of La Media Road Road.

Chula Vista Tract No. 16-0005, Otay Ranch Village 2 South Neighborhood R-17B(b), 78 Multifamily units located on 4.719 acres South of Santa Victoria Road, east of Heritage Road and west of La Media Road Road.

Chula Vista Tract No. 15-0007, Otay Ranch Planning Area 12, 292 Multifamily units located on 36.194 acres South of Olympic Parkway, east of SR125 and west of Eastlake Parkway.

Chula Vista Tract No. 15-02, Villa Del Oro, 80 Multifamily units located on 2.482 acres South of Arizona Street, West of Broadway North of Moss Street.

Specifically, the City Engineer has caused the maps to be examined and has made the following findings:

- (1) The maps substantially conform to the approved tentative maps, and any approved alterations thereof and any conditions of approval imposed with said tentative maps.
- (2) The maps comply with the provisions of the Subdivision Map Act and any local ordinances applicable at the time of approval of the tentative maps.
- (3) The maps are technically correct.

Said maps will be finalized and recorded, unless an interested party files a valid appeal of the City Engineer's action to City Council no later than 2:00 p.m., 10 calendar days from the date of this City Council meeting. A valid appeal must identify the improper/incorrect finding and the basis for such conclusion.
