RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING \$179,239 FROM THE U.S.
DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND
APPROPRIATING SAID FUNDS TO THE FEDERAL GRANTS
FUND FOR THE STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the San Diego County Office of Emergency Services, who administers the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP), has notified the City of the fiscal year 2014 SHSP award in the amount of \$179,239; and

WHEREAS, the State Homeland Security Program is designed to improve domestic terrorism preparedness of state and local governments by addressing equipment, training, exercises and planning needs; and

WHEREAS, grant funds from the State Homeland Security Program are restricted in how they can be spent and cannot supplant normal budgetary items for the City; and

WHEREAS, the fiscal year 2014 SHSP funds will purchase equipment that will be used by the City's first responders and Emergency Operations Center personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED with the above findings incorporated herein, the City Council of the City of Chula Vista does hereby accept \$179,239 from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and appropriate \$153,239 to supplies and services and \$26,000 to the personnel category of the Federal Grants Fund for the State Homeland Security Program.
