RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CHULA VISTA DESIGNATING AUTHORIZED AGENTS TO  
ACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY FOR PURPOSES OF  
OBTAINING STATE OR FEDERAL ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Chula Vista Municipal Code, Chapter 2.14 [Emergency Organization Department], designates the City Manager as the Director of Emergency Services, who is empowered to control and direct the effort of the emergency organization of this city;

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services has appointed the Deputy City Managers as the Assistant Director of Emergency Services respectively, to serve in the absence of the Director;

WHEREAS, the Emergency Services Coordinator is responsible for coordinating the activities of the City's Emergency Management Program, including preparing, overseeing, and tracking reimbursement claims to state and federal agencies;

WHEREAS, the State Office of Emergency Services ("Cal. OES") requires that non-state agencies, like the City of Chula Vista, adopt a resolution (including via the Cal OES 130 Resolution) to designate individuals (by position title) to serve as authorized persons to act on behalf of the City for the purposes of obtaining federal financial assistance under Public Law 93-288 as amended by the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act of 1988, and/or state financial assistance under the California Disaster Assistance Act; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, Assistant City Manager, and Emergency Services Coordinator, are appropriate individuals to act on behalf of the City for the purposes of obtaining federal financial assistance under Public Law 93-288 as amended by the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act of 1988, and/or state financial assistance under the California Disaster Assistance Act given their duties, as stated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that the City Manager, as the Director of Emergency Services, the Deputy City Managers, as the Assistant Director of Emergency Services, and the Emergency Services Coordinator are designated as authorized agents and hereby authorized to execute for and on behalf of the City of Chula Vista for the purposes of obtaining federal financial assistance under Public Law 93-288 as amended by the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act of 1988, and/or state financial assistance under the California Disaster Assistance Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista that the City of Chula Vista hereby authorizes its agents to provide to the Governor's Office of Emergency Services for all matters pertaining to such state disaster assistance the assurances and agreements required.

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista that it adopts the attendant Cal OES 130 Resolution (a copy of which is on file with the City Clerk's Office), in the form substantially presented, and that the City Manager may make such minor modifications to said Cal OES 130 Resolution as may be required or approved by the City Attorney.
