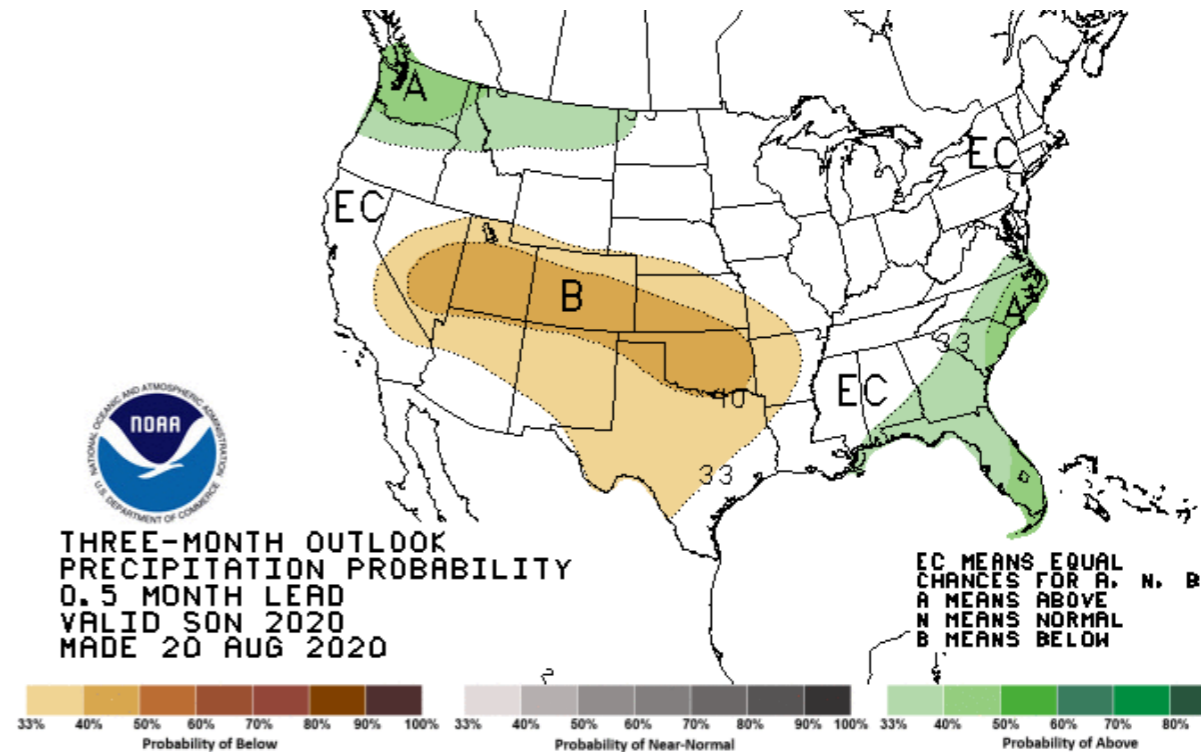
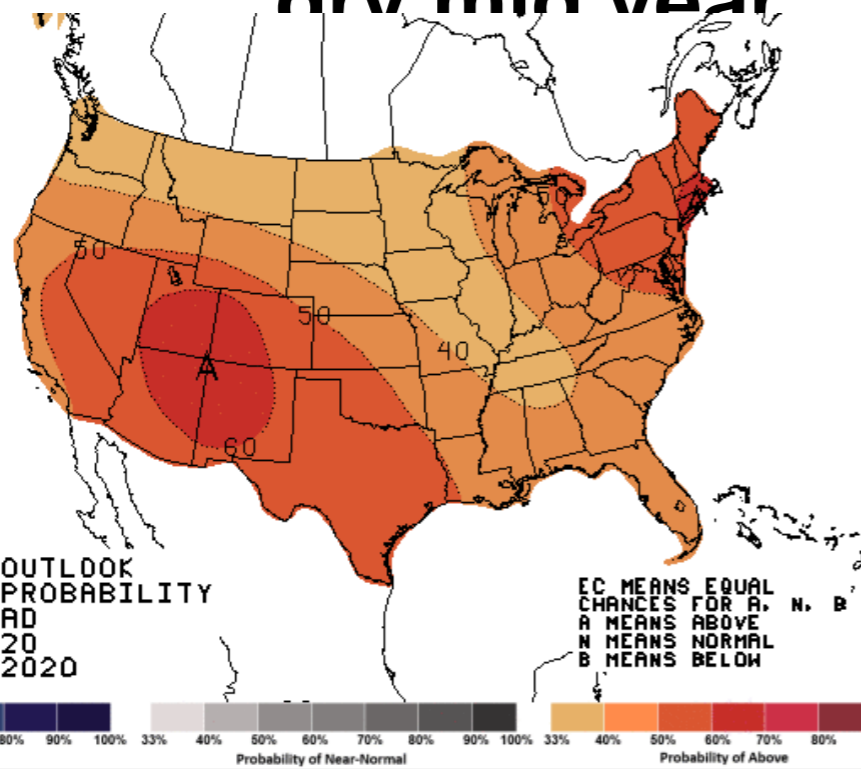




2020 Fire Season

Weather Outlook

- September – November
 - Above normal temperatures, near normal precipitation
 - Very dry fuels from left over from wet winter, but dry mid year

Cool Zone Open

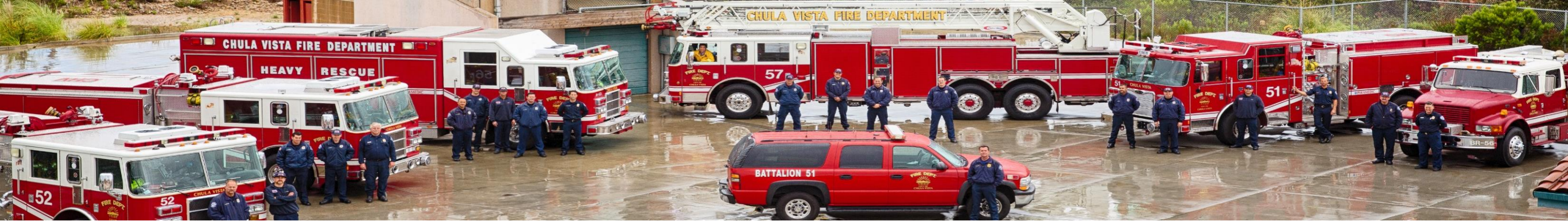
- Collaboration with Sears and Recreation Department

- Stay informed - register for AlertSanDiego



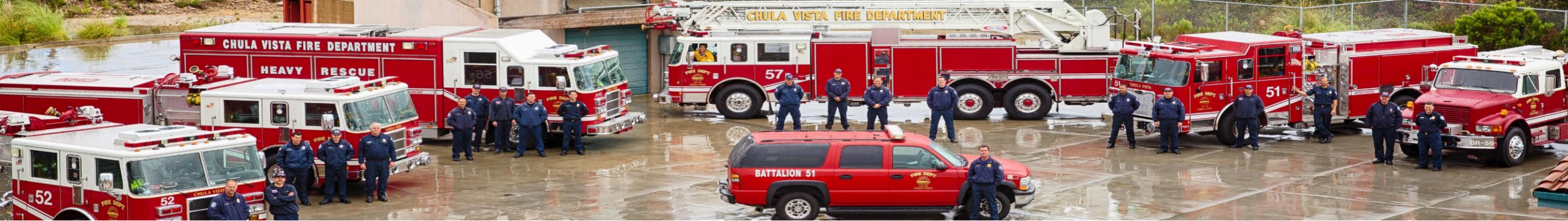


2020 Fire Season

BR54



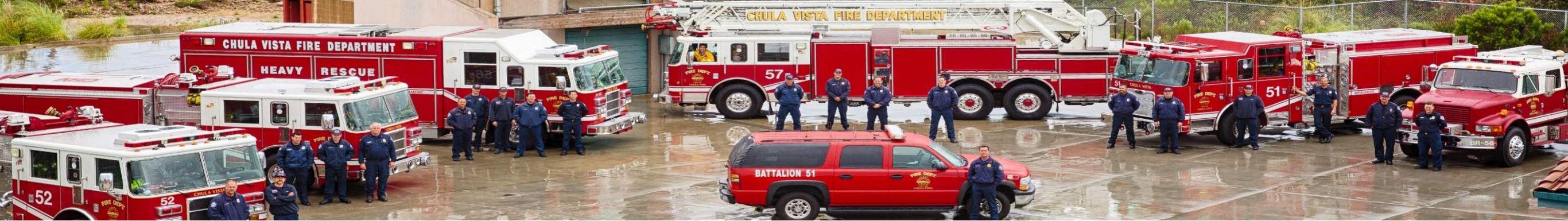


2020 Fire Season

2020 Fire Season

Vegetation Fires in Chula Vista

- 58 vegetation fires since July 1, 2020
- Mutual aid provided by:
 - San Diego Fire-Rescue
 - Imperial Beach Fire Department
 - National City Fire Department
 - San Miguel Fire Protection District
 - Ca Department of Forestry





2020 Fire Season

- **Positive impact from Measure A**
 - 4.0 Staffing
 - Added capability with SQUAD crews
- **Real time drone footage**
- **Deployments and Mutual Aid**
 - 14 Fires
 - Ranging from Los Angeles to Butte County
- **California Fire Assistance Agreement**
