2015 STARLIGHT PARADE GRAND MARSHAL TONY RASO



Meet the Grand Marshal for the 2015 Starlight Parade: Anthony "Tony" Raso Jr., owner of the famous La Bella Pizza Garden on Third Avenue in historic downtown Chula Vista.

The Raso family and their old-school Italian restaurant are well known to generations of Chula Vistans. In fact, La Bella is celebrating its 60th anniversary this year!

It all began when Tony's father Anthony Raso Sr. - better known as "Papa" - and his wife Kitty moved

here from New York in 1954. In 1955 they opened La Bella's (as the locals call it) in the same location where it currently stands. At first, Papa Tony did the cooking while Kitty waited tables. Soon, the restaurant's popularity, and the size of its staff, grew too large to be just a two-person operation. The restaurant is now the oldest in Chula Vista, still serving hearty home-style Italian classics seven days a week. Some years ago the restaurant added an adjacent café and game room that's popular with families, and more recently committed to a significantly upgraded menu of fine craft beers.

It was Papa Tony's and Kitty's love for the community that brought people together. Back in 1964 Kitty spoke out in the press to try to change the world when her daughter Phyllis and three teenagers were killed by a drunk driver who only got three months in jail. Her efforts in the community earned her the nickname of "Mayor of Third Avenue" 25 years ago, and she was named the Grand Marshal of what was then known as the Starlight Yule Parade. Now Tony Jr. shares the honor of the same title his mother held years before.

"Papa" Tony Raso passed away in 2005 (he was still flipping pizza dough in the restaurant's kitchen the day before), and Kitty died in 2010. Today Tony Jr. runs La Bella with his older brother Joe, and their longtime associate Stan Dale. Tony is a graduate of Hilltop High School in Chula Vista, and studied business at San Diego City College.
