4/2/20 @ 0800 – Hazim Gorges (owner of the Keg N Bottle at 677 H St) called to PROTEST the license. Reports there are too many bums in the area. [REDACTED]

4/2/20 @ 1116 – Jelaine Selman called to PROTEST the license. Reports there is already another liquor store in the area and thinks this one will attract more homeless and more graffiti. [REDACTED]

4/3/20 @ 1359 – Doug Waters called to PROTEST the license. Reports the homeless are already destroying the area. Another liquor store would just provide them even easier access to alcohol. [REDACTED]

4/2/20 @ 1759 – Raffe Gorges called to PROTEST. Raffe is Hazim Gorges son, says there is a problem with homeless in the area and feels that another license will increase the amount of homeless in the area. [REDACTED]

4/08/20 @ 1303 – Lebron Soges [REDACTED] PROTESTS the license because of the proximity to Keg N Bottle.

4/29/20 @ 1500 – Emily Stone called to PROTEST the license. Concerns with the transients in the area camping out and loitering in the shopping center across the way – says there are too many already in the area and selling beer and wine and adding more will only add to the problem.
