RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING THE 2020 REGIONAL ANALYSIS OF IMPEDIMENTS TO FAIR HOUSING CHOICE (AI) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO CERTIFY AND SUBMIT THE AI TO U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Chula Vista receives federal Community Development Block (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) funds from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, HUD requires that all state, county. and local governments receiving Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME funds prepare an Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing ("AI") every five years; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with California Government Code 65583(b)(10), as a component of a jurisdiction's Housing Element (HE), a jurisdiction must affirmatively further fair housing and include an Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice; and

WHEREAS, the AI identifies fair housing impediments that affect both the region and the City and provides recommendations to remedy the impediments and further fair housing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Chula Vista collaborated with other entitlement jurisdictions in the San Diego Region and has contracted with Veronica Tam and Associates to complete an AI on behalf of the jurisdictions; and,

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public review period was held from May 22, 2020 through June 22, 2020 to consider public input on the AI.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it accepts the 2020 Regional Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it authorizes the City Manager or designee to certify and submit the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
