RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CHULA VISTA DESIGNATING THE CITY'S AGENTS TO  
PROVIDE ALL NECESSARY ASSURANCES AND  
AGREEMENTS REQUIRED BY THE CALIFORNIA'S  
GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES

WHEREAS, in 2009 the City applied for a pre-disaster mitigation grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for brush removal to create a 60 foot defensible space for the Fire Department to defend approximately 230 homes in the Rice Canyon open space area in Rancho Del Rey; and

WHEREAS, on September 5, 2013 the City received notification from the State of California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) that the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) approved the City's subgrant application in the amount of \$386,310; and

WHEREAS, in order to receive payment all subgrantees must have an updated Grant Assurances on file with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CAL OES); and

WHEREAS, the City's designee must be authorized by Resolution to provide all necessary assurances and agreements required by the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CAL OES):

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Chula Vista does hereby authorize the Director of Public Works or his designee to provide all necessary assurances and agreement required by the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CAL OES).
