#### NOTICE OF REVIEW AND PENDING APPROVAL OF FINAL MAP(S)

In accordance with California Government Code Section 66458(d), notice is hereby given that the City Engineer has reviewed and, immediately following this City Council meeting of November 21, 2017, will approve the following final map:

Chula Vista Tract No. 16-0006, Portion of Otay Ranch Village 2 South, 206 Lots on 43.795 Acres. Specifically, the City Engineer has caused the map(s) to be examined and has made the following findings:
