RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CHULA VISTA APPROPRIATING \$155,451 TO THE POLICE
GRANT FUND FOR THE PUBLIC SAFETY REALIGNMENT

WHEREAS, in 2011, Governor Edmund G. Brown Jr. signed Assembly Bill (AB) 109 and AB 117, legislation which enables California to close the revolving door of low-level inmates cycling in and out of state prisons; and

WHEREAS, this legislation implemented the 2011 Public Safety Realignment, provides funding to counties to develop and implement evidence-based practices and alternatives to incarceration to limit future crimes and reduce victimization; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Realignment is funded with a dedicated portion of state sales tax revenue and Vehicle License Fees (VLF) outlined in trailer bills AB 118 and SB 89; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has been designated as the fiscal agent of Public Safety Realignment funds for the San Diego County region; and

WHEREAS, the county allocation will be disbursed to each city based on its percentage of population as determined by the California Department of Finance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Chula Vista has been allocated \$155,451 this fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City Council of the City of Chula Vista does hereby appropriate \$15,451 to supplies and services and \$140,000 to the capital category of the Police Grant Fund to be fully offset by Public Safety Realignment revenues.
