RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE FORMAL BID REQUIREMENT AND AUTHORIZING CITY TO RECEIVE SERVICES FROM MERZ CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

WHEREAS, on January 13, 2015, City Council accepted \$80,000 grant funding from the U.S Department of Homeland Security to reinforce the front counter in the Police Department's lobby with bullet resistant glass and paneling and reinforce the Police Department's south facing door that leads onto Center Street with steel mesh screening covering blast resistant glass; and

WHEREAS, after seeking multiple proposals, Merz Construction Company was selected for this facility security enhancement project; and

WHEREAS, since the Public Works Department also uses the services of Merz Construction Company for other capital improvement projects, the total cost from this vendor will exceed the \$100,000 spending threshold per the City's purchasing policies; and

WHEREAS, because of the City's experience in dealing with Merz Construction Company and the knowledge of their quality of service, the Police Department is requesting to waive the competitive formal bid requirement; and

WHEREAS, Chula Vista Municipal Code Section 2.56.070(B)(4) permits the City Council to waive formal competitive bidding requirements when a commodity or services is available from only one known source as the result of unique performance capabilities and manufacturing processes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Chula Vista does hereby waive the competitive formal bid requirements and authorize the City to receive services from Merz Construction Company for capital improvement projects.
