


# Background

- UCSP adopted by City Council in April 2007
- 2012 was the fifth year of implementing the UCSP
- 2013 Five-year review initiated
  - Rezone areas
  - Minimal development activity
  - Identified development issues
  - Text revisions to reflect changes since 2007










- Remove minimum floor area ratio (FAR)
- Remove lot coverage
- Revise the Land Use Matrix
- Allow some commercial/office in Village 1 subdistrict
- UCSP consistency with Bikeway Master Plan
- Text edits
- Update UCSP area map to include the existing zones








# Lot Coverage

- Lot coverage not an effective development tool
- Other existing standards that facilitate development
- Palomar Gateway specific plan and Eastern Urban Center plan do not include lot coverage as a development standard
- Remove Lot Coverage development standard












# Other Updates

- Text revisions/clarifications reflecting other changes




