WHEREAS, on April 23, 2015, the Planning Commission held a duly noticed joint public meeting with the City Council to consider the 2015 GMOC Annual Report, and to make recommendations to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Planning Commission of the City of Chula Vista does hereby accept and forward the 2015 GMOC Annual Report and recommendations contained therein to the City Council for consideration.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Planning Commission recommends that the City Council accept the 2015 GMOC Annual Report.
