RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING \$77,387 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2016/2017 ADOPTED BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING SAID FUNDS TO THE POLICE GRANT FUND

WHEREAS, the Police Department has recently received notice of grant funding in the amount of \$77,387 from the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC); and

WHEREAS, the goal of this grant is to reduce the availability of alcohol to minors and reduce alcohol-related crime through multiple enforcement, educational and prevention programs conducted by ABC Agents and local law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, throughout the one-year grant period of July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017, Minor Decoy and Shoulder Tap Decoy operations, and Informed Merchants Preventing Alcohol-Related Crime Tendency (IMPACT) inspections will be conducted on an overtime basis; and

WHEREAS, funds provided by this grant will also be used for ABC training; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds provided by the ABC will completely offset the total costs of this program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City Council of the City of Chula Vista that it accepts \$77,387 from the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it amends the fiscal year 2016/2017 adopted budget by appropriating \$71,437 to personnel services and \$5,950 to the supplies and services category of the Police Grant Fund.
