RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR PREPARATION OF A PEDESTRIAN CONNECTIVITY AND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PLAN BETWEEN THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AND COLE & ASSOCIATES, INC. AND APPROPRIATING \$30,000 FROM THE AVAILABLE BALANCE OF THE TRANSNET FUND TO CIP GG222, "ASSET MANAGEMENT" (4/5 VOTE REQUIRED)

WHEREAS, City requires professional services to collect data on the condition of the City's pedestrian infrastructure and prepare a Pedestrian Connectivity and Infrastructure Improvement Plan; and

WHEREAS, in order to procure these services, City solicited proposals in accordance with Chula Vista Municipal Code Section 2.56.110, received five proposals, conducted interviews, and selected Consultant as the most qualified amongst those submitting; and

WHEREAS, Consultant represents that it is knowledgeable and experienced regarding the 2010 Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, California Title 24, the Access Board's Public Right of Way Guidelines, and the U.S. Department of Transportation's ADA Standards for Transportation; and

WHEREAS, Consultant represents that it is experienced and staffed in a manner such that it can deliver the services required of Consultant to City in accordance with the time frames and the terms and conditions of this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends appropriating an additional \$30,000 from the available balance in the TransNet Fund to provide sufficient funds for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it approves the agreement for \$443,230.34 for preparation of a Pedestrian Connectivity and Infrastructure Improvement Plan between the City and Cole & Associates, Inc. in the form presented, with such minor modifications as may be required or approved by the City Attorney, a copy of which shall be kept on file in the Office of the City Engineer, and authorizes and directs the Mayor to execute same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it appropriates \$30,000 from the available balance of the TransNet Fund to CIP GG222, "Asset Management".
