RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING \$52,426 FROM THE CALIFORNIA BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS AND APPROPRIATING SAID FUNDS TO THE POLICE GRANT FUND FOR HOMELESS OUTREACH EFFORTS

WHEREAS, the Police Department has been awarded \$52,426 grant funding from the California Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) for the Homeless Outreach Team; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the Homeless Outreach Team is to address environmental and societal issues related to the living conditions of the homeless; and

WHEREAS, the BSCC grant funds will offset overtime and transportation costs of the Homeless Outreach Team as follows: \$44,926 of the grant will be allocated to the personnel category to fund overtime, and \$7,500 will be allocated to the supplies and services category to fund travel and other urgent needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it accepts \$52,426 from the California Board of State and Community Corrections and appropriates said funds to the Police Grant Fund for homeless outreach efforts.
