RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CHULA VISTA APPROVING THE IMPLEMENTATION
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE ORGANIZED
CRIME DRUG ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCE TO SUPPORT
THE SAN DIEGO REGION STRIKE FORCE AND
APPROVING THE THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE BUILDING
LEASE

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2010, the Police Department entered into a lease agreement for the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) to occupy office space in San Diego to support operations of the San Diego Region Strike Force; and

WHEREAS, as the tenant under the lease, the City is fully reimbursed by OCDETF for all expenses associated with the rental/operation/maintenance/renovation of the office space and receives a fee for administering said expenses; and

WHEREAS, the current lease for the OCDETF office space expires on October 31, 2017, and staff is requesting approval of an implementation agreement with OCDETF to extend the existing lease until October 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, staff also is requesting approval of the third amendment to the building lease, titled Third Amendment to Standard Industrial Net Lease.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it approves the implementation agreement between the City and the Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force to support the San Diego Region Strike Force, in the form presented, with such minor modifications as may be required or approved by the City Attorney, a copy of which shall be kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk, and authorizes and directs the City Manager to execute same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it approves the third amendment to the building lease, in the form presented, with such minor modifications as may be required or approved by the City Attorney, a copy of which shall be kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk, and authorizes and directs the City Manager to execute same.
