

The Balboa

The Balboa Bar & Grill has signed a lease on Third Avenue. Owner and Bonita-native Tom Logsdon stated "I'm very excited to be bringing The Balboa to the community I grew up in. There are great things going on in Chula Vista and I'm proud to be part of that."

Opening with a beer & wine license and the goal to get a full liquor license quickly so that it can offer its lineup of craft cocktails. The Balboa South is anticipated to open early 2018.



Groundswell Brewing Co.

Groundswell Brewing Company, owned by Chula Vista residents, will soon open its third tasting facility at 258 Third Avenue.

The space will offer beer on draft, available for onsite consumption in pints, flights, or for takeaway in growlers. Groundswell has high hopes to add a future kitchen on site.
