Commercial Cannabis

Proposed ordinance Feb. 27, 2018

February 6, 2018 Meeting

- Council consideration of draft commercial cannabis ordinance
- Council requested that staff reconsider:
 - Loosening qualifications to widen pool of qualified applicants
 - Requiring site identification in Phase One of the application process

Proposed ordinance

- Staff has incorporated changes to address both concerns
 - Qualifications
 - Separated out owner vs. manager experience
 - expanded owner experience to include operation for at least three years of any lawful business in Chula Vista with 10 or more employees
 - Location
 - Now require site identification in Phase One Application

Additional modifications

• Examples:

- Clarifies that Storefront Retailers can be located in Mixed-Use Zones and that residences in Mixed-Use Zones are not sensitive receptors
- Enhances City's ability to reject applications from persons who have been involved in unlawful activity
- Notes that pipeline provisions will be established and adopted through regulations
- Updates the license renewal section
- Includes updated measuring path illustrations
- Provided in strike-out, underline text

Tax Measure

- Staff recommend November 2018 ballot
- Request direction from Council
 - Form of Tax
 - Gross Receipts Tax for all Businesses
 - Square Footage Tax for some, Gross Receipts for others
 - Combined Square Footage & Gross Receipts Tax for all or some
 - Amount of Tax
 - Square Footage (up to 25\$ per square foot)
 - Gross Receipts (up to 15%)
