RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING \$6,007 FROM THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES AND APPROPRIATING SAID FUNDS TO THE POLICE GRANTS SECTION OF THE FEDERAL GRANTS FUND FOR THE COVERDELL FORENSIC SCIENCE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Police Department has been awarded \$6,007 in grant funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the Coverdell program is to improve the quality, timeliness, and credibility of forensic science services over current operations; and

WHEREAS, the Coverdell funds will be used to provide education and training to crime laboratory personnel to ensure that they can effectively perform their laboratory assignments; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds provided by the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services will be appropriated to the supplies and services category of the Police Grant Fund and will completely offset the total costs of this program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista that it accepts \$6,007 from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services and appropriates said funds to the Police Grants Section of the Federal Grants Fund for the Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Program.
