RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CHULA VISTA WAIVING THE CONSULTANT SELECTION
PROCESS AND APPROVING A YOUTH COUNSELING
SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CHULA
VISTA AND SOUTH BAY COMMUNITY SERVICES

WHEREAS, South Bay Community Services and the Police Department have worked together since 1985 providing a variety of services for juveniles and their families; and

WHEREAS, South Bay Community Services has tailored their programs to meet the needs of the City, and their experience, qualifications and community presence make them a unique service provider; and

WHEREAS, the agreement is effective July 1, 2018 and will expire on June 30, 2019, and may be extended an additional four years upon mutual agreement; and

WHEREAS, Consultant warrants and represents that it is experienced and staffed in a manner such that it can deliver the services required of Consultant to City in accordance with the time frames and the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it waives the consultant selection process pursuant to Chula Vista Municipal Code Chapter 2.56; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista that it approves the Youth Counseling Services Agreement, between the City and South Bay Community Services, in the form presented, with such minor modifications as may be required or approved by the City Attorney, a copy of which shall be kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk, and authorizes and directs the Mayor to execute same.
