RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING THE PERFORMING AND
VISUAL ARTS GRANT REVIEW PANEL'S GRANT AWARD
RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-19 WITH A
TOTAL MONETARY GRANT AWARD FOR THIS FISCAL
YEAR TOTALING \$78,730 DOLLARS

WHEREAS, in 1997, the City Council approved a Sublease with Live Nation, Inc. that established a process whereby the proceeds from ticket sales at the Amphitheater would be paid to the City and utilized for a Performing and Visual Arts Fund (PVAG Fund), to stimulate and grow Cultural Arts in the City of Chula Vista; and

WHEREAS, all grant money awarded will directly fund artists, artistic collaborations, materials such as supplies and costumes for cultural arts programs/performance, and to assist in strengthening and growing the cultural arts scene in Chula Vista; and

WHEREAS, the proceeds received from Live Nation for Fiscal Year 2019 (FY19) total \$71,074 dollars; and

WHEREAS, there is \$20,765 dollars in residual 2018 grant monies (residual monies) in the PVAG fund, and \$12,100 of the residual monies are encumbered for the FY18 Cultural Arts Work Program, leaving a total of \$79,739 dollars available to award for FY19; and

WHEREAS, there were 28 applications received for FY19, which included applications from individual artists, City departments, and a variety of arts organizations and non-profits; and

WHEREAS, the Performing and Visual Arts Grant Review Panel (Review Panel) reviewed and scored assigned applications, convened on May 7, 2018, and approved the FY19 grant recommendations in the amount of \$78,730 dollars in grant awards; and

WHEREAS, at a regularly scheduled meeting on May 14th, 2018, the Cultural Arts Commission accepted the Review Panel's FY19 grant recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it hereby accepts the PVAG Review Panel's FY19 recommendations, in the form presented, a copy of which shall be kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
