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RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING \$222,000 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND APPROPRIATING \$70,000 TO THE POLICE GRANTS SECTION OF THE FEDERAL GRANT FUND

WHEREAS, since the events of September 11, 2001, the interception of terrorists and their weapons attempting entry across the nation's borders has become the priority mission of the U.S. Department of Security; and

WHEREAS, grant funding via "Operation Stonegarden" has been awarded by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security to the San Diego County region to facilitate regional partnerships and enhance border enforcement capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has been allocated \$222,000 for Operation Stonegarden to participate in regional enforcement efforts and support the mission of the operation; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds provided by U.S. Department of Homeland Security will completely offset the total costs of Operation Stonegarden.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it hereby accepts the \$222,000 from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and appropriates \$70,000 to the capital category, and directs staff to include \$152,000 in the personnel category of the subsequent FY19/20 budget in the Police Grants Section of the Federal Grant Fund for Operation Stonegarden.
