RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR "TRAFFIC SIGNAL MODIFICATIONS AT FIVE INTERSECTIONS IN THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA (CIP #TRF0407)" PROJECT TO T&M ELECTRIC INC., DBA PERRY ELECTRIC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,300,051; APPROPRIATING \$60,000 FROM THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL FUND AND \$332,448 OF HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS BASED ON UNANTICIPATED REVENUE TO TRF0407 (4/5 VOTE REQUIRED)

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.56 of the Chula Vista Municipal Code authorizes the City to contract for public works; and

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2019, the Department of Engineering and Capital Projects solicited bids for the "Traffic Signal Modifications at Five Intersections (TRF0407)" project in accordance with Chula Vista Municipal Code section 2.56.160.A; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2020, the Director of Engineering and Capital Projects received five (5) sealed bids for the "Traffic Signal Modifications at Five Intersections (TRF0407)" project; and

WHEREAS, the apparent low bid for the project was submitted by T&M Electric Inc. dba Perry Electric in the amount of \$1,300,051, which is below the Engineer's estimate of \$1,484,528.50 by \$184,478 (approximately 12.4% below the Engineer's estimate); and

WHEREAS, staff has determined that the bid submitted by Perry Electric is responsive in all material respects to the bid specifications/requirements, and that Perry Electric is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends awarding the contract to Perry Electric in the amount of \$1,300,051; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends appropriating \$60,000 from the available balance of the Traffic Signal Fund; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends appropriating \$332,448 from the Highway Safety Improvement Program fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista that it awards the contract for the "Traffic Signal Modifications at Five Intersections (TRF0407)" project to Perry Electric in the amount of \$1,300,051.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista that it appropriates \$60,000 from the available balance of the Traffic Signal Fund and \$332,448 of Highway Safety Improvement Program funds based on unanticipated revenue to TRF0407.
