RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF GRANT APPLICATIONS FOR THE HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM - CYCLE 10 THROUGH CALTRANS, AND STATING THE CITY'S ASSURANCE TO COMPLETE THE PROJECTS

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2020, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and the Federal Highway Administration announced the California Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) - Cycle 10 Call for Projects; and

WHEREAS, this Call for Projects is targeted for approximately \$220M in State funds exchanged from Federal HSIP funding; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the HSIP is to achieve a significant reduction in fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads; and

WHEREAS, for a project to be eligible, a specific problem must be identified for correction and the proposed countermeasure must correct or substantially improve the condition users; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the City apply for grant funding of the following three (3) candidate projects:
