## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR POLICE, FIRE, AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED PORT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City of Chula Vista (the "City") and the San Diego Unified Port District (the "Port District") have negotiated an agreement regarding police, fire, and emergency medical services to be provided by the City on the non-ad valorem tidelands trust property, owned by the Port District and located within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City (the "MSA); and

WHEREAS, the City has the capacity to provide police, fire, and emergency medical services to said Port District property; and

WHEREAS, the Port District will reimburse the City as set forth in the proposed MSA; and

WHEREAS, the current MSA will expire June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the proposed MSA will have a term from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2030; and

WHEREAS, the Port District Board of Commissioners approved the proposed MSA at their December 28, 2020 meeting, in the form presented in Exhibit 1 to this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it hereby approves the Agreement for Police, Fire, and Emergency Medical Services, between the City and the San Diego Unified Port District, in the form presented, with such minor modifications as may be required or approved by the City Attorney, a copy of which shall be kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk, and authorizes and directs the Mayor to execute the same.
