Council adopt the resolution.

The Director of Development Services has reviewed the proposed project for compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and has determined that the project qualifies for Class 1 Categorical Exemptions pursuant to Section 15301, Class 1 (b) (Existing Facilities) of the CEQA State Guidelines. Consistent with Section 15301(b), the proposed action would not result in a significant effect on the environment, create a cumulative impact, damage a scenic highway, be located on a site pursuant to Section 65962.5, or cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historical resource. The project involves no expansion of an existing use. Thus, no further environmental review is necessary.
