ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

Environmental Notice

DISCUSSION

Reappointments to the Civil Service Commission, Cultural Arts Commission, Growth Management Oversight Commission, and Planning Commission

Pursuant to the reappointment process established in Chula Vista Municipal Code section 2.25.055, prior to reappointment, the Mayor and City Council shall interview interested and eligible members who have served more than one year on specified City commissions whose members are nominated

and appointed by the full City Council. The specified commissions/seats that this process applies to are: all seats on the Cultural Arts, Growth Management Oversight, Planning, and Parks & Recreation Commissions, and the two seats on the Civil Service Commission whose members are appointed by the City Council directly. Following the interviews, the Mayor and City Council vote whether or not to reappoint the incumbents.
